On January 11, 2004 Anthony Canty, 48, of 46 East 110th Place, was arrested by Chicago Police officers after they observed him carrying a concealed weapon in the hallway of his apartment building. When the officers approached him, Canty fled into an apartment where he was found with three loaded semi-automatic pistols, crack cocaine, a mixture of heroin and cocaine, marijuana and thousands of dollars in counterfeit money. Canty, a former member of the Gangster Disciples street gang, has previous arrests for possession and distribution of narcotics as well as the unlawful use of a weapon.

Recently, Canty was sentenced to 30 years in a Federal prison, with no opportunity for parole.
