On September 10, 2004, Saleem Lake, 31, of 8824 S. Lowe, was arrested when tactical officers executing a search warrant in his apartment found a loaded handgun and 170 individually wrapped packages of crack. Lake is a member of the Black P Stones street gang.

Recently Lake was sentenced to 15 years in Federal prison after being convicted of being a felon in possession of a gun, possession of a gun in furtherance of a drug trafficking crime, possession of a gun with an obliterated serial number, and possession with intent to distribute more than 50 grams of crack. There is no parole in the Federal system.

If you carry a gun, you'll do really hard time a long way from home.
